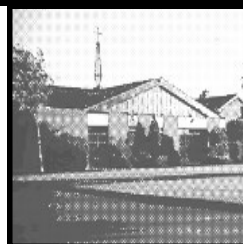

Holy Hour With Jesus

Just prior to the arrival of Pope Francis to Ireland, he issued a letter to *The People of God* in regards to the abuse crisis in our Church. In that letter he called the faithful to a penitential exercise of prayer and fasting for the crisis.

In response to the Successor of St. Peter, Fr. Bill will lead a **Holy Hour** next **Friday, 12th October, at 7.30pm in St. Mark's Church.** The hour will comprise of soft reflective music, praying Psalms, silent prayer and Benediction at the end.

All are welcome to come and pray in unity for healing for all those abused and to seek forgiveness for the Church. Even those who feel the pressures of life and are struggling with burdens, why not come along for an hour of rest and reflection.

This is an act of solidarity, which the Holy Father said "...summons us to fight all forms of...spiritual corruption ." Fr. Bill will commit to three days of fasting beforehand, and anyone who wishes to join him are very welcome.
